- Avoid pesticides in your lawn & garden
- Choose organic foods
- Turn off exterior lights at night
- Reduce, reuse, recycle
- Grow native plants
- Don't disturb nests and bird flocks
- Keep cats indoors and leash dogs
- Join a bird conservation organization
